## **Unpacking the Collect for Purity:**

Trust me (says she) it will be wonderful! No reading – no writing – just come! Beginning June 3rd

7:00-8:00 pm on Zoom.

"Almighty God, unto whom all hearts be open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid: cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of thy Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love thee, and worthily magnify thy holy Name; through Christ our Lord. Amen."

Sound familiar? We hear these words each Sunday at the opening of our liturgy but how often have you reflected upon the words? Theologian and Old Testament scholar, Walter Bruggemann, in his book, "Prayers for Privileged People," has taken each line of the prayer and written a reflection on it. Each reflection is inspiring and offers us an opportunity to engage with the text together. The class will meet weekly for 6 sessions for one hour June 3, 10, 24 (no class 6/17), July 1, 8, 15. Join each session ready to prayerfully listen, and willing to share your insight or feelings on the reading. It would be ideal to attend all the sessions but not necessary as each reflection stands alone. I hope you will consider joining me for this summer small group opportunity.
