EfM Recruitment for Fall class:
Do you want to deepen your Christian faith, learn how to articulate that faith, and let that faith inspire you into action? Have you already done EfM and would like to be involved again? Then join Education for Ministry (EfM)! More than bible study, EfM participants read and discuss the Old Testament (year 1), the New Testament (year 2), Church history (year 3), and ethics and spirituality (year 4). (You do not have to commit to all four program years nor complete in four consecutive years.) There is also a new 1-year overview called Wide Angle that is a great way to dip your toes in or return for a refresher if you have already completed the 4 year program. Through study, prayer, and reflection, mentors facilitate small group discussions and guide participants to examine life through an increasingly informed and inspired theological lens.
